In particular, the Committee will discuss the report by the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights, Navanethem Pillay, on "Strengthening the United National human rights treaty body system" of June 2012.

The Committee will hold a meeting with States parties in order to discuss its working methods, in particular its new optional list of issues prior to reporting procedure and its new procedure for the consideration of States parties in the absence of a report, and the impact of its decision to adopt a comprehensive reporting calendar on its future meeting time requirements.

8. Promotion of the Convention

Under this item, the Committee will discuss its involvement in and support for various events to continue promoting the Convention.

9. Issues pertaining to the Convention

Under this item, the Committee will discuss the adoption of a general comment on the rights of migrant workers in an irregular situation and members of their families, following its day of general discussion at its fifteenth session.
