Article 31 provides for an individual complaint mechanism. The Committee on Enforced Disappearances may receive and consider communications from or on behalf of individuals subject to its jurisdiction who claim to be victims of a violation by a State Party of the provisions of the Convention.

¹ "Ratification" includes ratification, accession or succession.

In the case of the Enforced Disappearance Convention - Articles 31, 32 and 42, the State has the option of making a declaration in accordance with the terms of the Convention.

Article 32 provides for an inter-state complaint mechanism. The Committee on Enforced Disappearances may receive and consider communications to the effect that a State Party claims that another State Party is not fulfilling its obligations under the Convention.

Article 42 provides that a State my declare it does not consider itself bound by the requirement in Article 42(1) to refer disputes between two or more States parties that are not resolved by negotiation or through the procedures set out in the Convention to arbitration or to the International Court of Justice.

- Formerly Libyan Arab Jamahiriya. In August 2011, the Permanent Mission of Libya notified the Secretary-General of a Declaration by the National Transitional Council of 3 August changing the official name of the Libyan Arab Jamahiriya to "Libya" and changing Libya's national flag.
- The Republic of South Sudan formally seceded from Sudan on 9 July 2011, as a result of an internally monitored referendum held in January 2011, and was admitted as a U.N. member state by the General Assembly on 14 July 2011.
